HEALTHY RECIPE OF THE WEEK

Blueberry Smoothie

Ingredients

100ml milk, 75g fresh blueberries, 75q fresh strawberries, 2 dates (stones removed), 100ml apple juice.

Instructions

- 1. Wash the strawberries and blueberries. Remove the stone of the dates with your clean fingers.
- 2. Using the measuring jug, measure out the milk and apple juice.
- 3. Put the milk, apple juice, fruit and dates into the food processor and blend for 10 seconds until there are no lumps of fruit left.
