## Easter Assembly



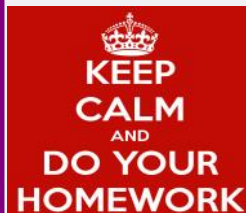
Thank you to all parents who attended the Assembly this morning. The EUFS phase were fantastic in their Chocolate Factory Performance. Well done!
