<u>Head lice</u>

A new term, our children back together, just what <u>HEAD LICE</u> love! Moving around from head to head, multiplying. Could we please remind parents /caregivers to tie back long or loose flowing hair, ideally in a plait or bun. It is best practice to check your child's hair at least weekly, the ideal time to do this is after the hair has been washed but before you remove the conditioner. Using a close toothed plastic comb or 'detection' comb insert the comb at the roots and pass down full length of the hair section by section. Remember if head lice are found all the family will need to be treated and retreated every 3 days for 2 weeks.
