
Thornton's Behaviour Expectations

Thank you to all the parents/carers who attended the parent/carer information session about behaviour on Monday this week. If you weren't able to attend, these were the things we talked about:



- The 3 key behaviour expectations: Ready, Respectful, Safe
- Recognition Boards in classrooms to focus on specific learning attitudes and changed at least weekly
- Praise postcards posted home weekly to recognise those fantastic children who have 'qone 'above and beyond'
- Surprise, positive telephone calls home to parents/carers to share good news and celebrate achievement
- Ideas for a whole school approach to reward individuals in such a way that they can donate fund-raised money to either a local, national or global charity
- An approach to dealing with inappropriate behaviour that starts with staff thinking WHU this behaviour might have happened in the first place before choosing the best response
- Future training for staff about everyone using a common language when responding to inappropriate behaviour


