Jasbinder Bilan

Jasbinder Bilan is an Indian born British author and teacher. She won the Costa Book Award prize for children's literature for her magical novel Asha and the Spirit Bird. This story was inspired by her manjee (grandmother). She also spoke to her mother about growing up in India and what it was like growing up on their farm. Jasbinder studied black and white family photographs and imagined being there. She believes that all of this helped her to create a strong setting for the story of Asha and the Spirit Bird.

- When asked about her book India Incredible India, Jasbinder said that if she could travel into the past she would go to the ancient Indus Valley in Gujarat, where things like dominos, dice and buttons were invented.
- She has always had a close connection with nature and her happiest times are when she is walking along a beach or through a forest.
- Jasbinder is a member of Authors 4 Oceans, which campaigns to clean our waters of plastic.
- As a child, she loved spending time in Wollaton, a place in Nottingham, where she allowed her imagination to run wild. She made up stories as she wandered the grounds with her dog Jasbinder
