Healthy Flapjacks

<u>Ingredients:</u>

50g prunes (chopped), dried 50g apricots (chopped), dried 50g raisins 175g porridge oats



oats 50g butter 3 tbsp Golden syrup 1 eqq, beaten

<u>Method:</u>

1. Preheat the oven to gas mark 4/180°C/ Fan oven 170°C

2. Mix all the dry ingredients together.

3. Add melted butter with syrup (or honey)

into dry ingredients and combine well.

4. Beat the egg and when the fruit and oat mixture has cooled slightly, add this to the mixture.

5. Turn the mixture into lightly greased 9 × 7 inch/22 × 18cm baking tin.

6. Bake for 15–20 minutes until a pale golden brown.


