School Dinners and Parent Pay

In September your child may not be eligible for free school meals automatically. We will ask you to complete a contact form and we can find out for you.

We are a cashless school and we use parent pay for school trips and school dinner payments. If you are eligible your child will get free school meals and the school will also receive extra funding too. All parents will be issued with a parent pay account in September.

Our food is all cooked in house and we use halal certified suppliers. We have a variety of theme days throughout the year and our menu reflects this such as; Chinese new year and Bastille Day.
