We are introducing a new initiative this term to help improve our school attendance. - Pupils will need to attend school for 5 consecutive days without any absences during the two school weeks.

- Pupils will need to ensure they have no late marks for 5 days (unless they have a medical appointment) and can arrive from 8.30am, but no later than 8.45am.
