## Hello everyone

On behalf of all the Governors and staff, thank you to all our children and parents/carers who have embraced our transition into a new way of delivering 'Remote Learning'. We totally appreciate how challenging it is for everyone to try to organise families, often with several learners in the home, to access online learning, and especially with limited or no devices or connectivity.

School managed to secure **137 DfE loaned laptops** which have now all been allocated. We are aware that we have not managed to meet all the requests we have received but we are doing our very best to try and source additional laptops for those children who still require them. We will contact you if we are successful with getting some more.

I also want to emphasise that **paper packs are always available weekly** to support the children's learning. These can be collected on Monday each week from the Year Group boxes on

tables outside the main Reception. Individual paper packs to support SEND children are held in Reception and can also be collected from Monday each week. Photos of work can be emailed to teachers for feedback—

We have now reached the end of our third week of using the **Google Classroom** platform to help engage our children with online learning. It has been a very eventful 3 weeks with staff having to learn how to set-up and run a totally new way of learning online, as well as try and



communicate this remotely to children and parents/carers. We are truly grateful for your patience and understanding as we do everything we can to troubleshoot and support the technological side of this! I have been really impressed with our staff who now find themselves acting as IT support to guide children and parents/carers through the process of logging on and
