TikTok Update Parental Controls

TikTok is used by many teenagers and sometimes children younger than 13 despite its terms and conditions. Using the new Family Pairing feature can allow parents to guide their child's TikTok experience in a safer way. Features include:

Search: Decide what can be searched for. This includes content, users, hashtags, or sounds

Screen Time Management: Sets how long your teen can spend on TikTok each day

Discoverability: Decide on the account being private (you decide who can see their content) or public (anyone can search and view content)

Free school meals – are you now eligible?

Due to the impact of COVID-19 some families have now become eligible for benefits to related free school meals. This not only enables your child to have a free school meal but also enables discounts and other support during their time in school. Changes to Statutory Assessments 2020-2021

Each year, a range of statutory tests are usually taken by pupils in the summer term (KS2 SATs in Year 6). The government have recently published new guidance for 2020-2021 stating:

- The KS2 SPaG test has been cancelled (Y6)
- Teachers do not need to assess pupils for Science (Y6)
- Y6 will still have to take the reading test (x1) and the maths arithmetic and reasoning tests (x3)
- Y6 writing will be assessed by their teachers in the usual way

The government had planned to introduce a multiplication check for Y4 last year and it was postponed until this year. They have now said that it is optional and we will shortly make a decision as to whether or not our Y4 children take this test.

We are aware that Eid-al-Fitr is estimated to be on Wed 12th May and the Y6 SATs are scheduled for the 10th -12th May. The government has given the schools greater flexibility in timetabling the tests so it may be that we can change the date of some tests, following further

discussions with staff and parents. We will keep you updated about this.
