



### Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)



- Before you listen to the story, predict what you think might happen in the story. How do you know? Use evidence from the book cover.
- Once you have listened to the story, think about these questions and discuss them with a family member:



- Carla's classmates make fun of her sandwich choices. Tell about a time when you or someone you know was being made fun. How did that experience make you feel?
- Draw a picture when you felt one of the emotions that Carla felt and show member of your family. Can they guess the emotion?

- 4. Write a <u>newspaper report</u> of the events from the video, interview the teacher, parents and policemen.

You can design it in any way you want but they want the name 'Fairtrade' to be on the design. Some things you may like to use are: crayons, paint, glitter, tissue paper and wool.

- how it will benefit workers
- emotions
- better pay
- how it may be unfair



Research about the different foods from <a href="Italy">Italy</a>, <a href="France">France</a> and <a href="Chile">Chile</a>. Pick two foods from each country, create a spider diagram for each food and write four points about each food.



Write a short paragraph about Fairtrade using the words in the table below.
