Year 4 Curriculum Autumn Term

Maths

<u> Times Tables</u>

Children need to know their times tables fluently. All children have access to Times Tables Rockstars. Every child in year 4 has a login for this in their planners. Please ensure that the children are using this regularly.

By the end of year 4 children are expected to know all their times tables! They also have a Multiplication Tables Check in June 2023 to check their progress.



<u>My Maths</u>

All children in year 4 have a login for My Maths in their planners. The children can access lessons online as well as the homework that has been assigned to them. Homework is set weekly. The homework will always be linked to whatever topic has been covered that week. This is a great way for your child to consolidate what they have learnt in school. We urge you to encourage your children to log in regularly. There are also some fun maths games for the children to play and learn!

In the Autumn Term we will cover; place value, addition and subtraction, measurement, area and multiplication and division.

Where possible please support your child.





Reading Reading Plus is a good way to develop the children's reading and comprehension skills. It also helps to

motivate them to become successful readers. It is so important that you encourage your child to read a little bit EVERDAY, even if it is

only for a short period of time. Please ask them questions about what they have read and what they liked about it. This helps to see if they have

understood what they have read. This will have a huge impact on their learning across the curriculum. Their login details are in their planners.

In addition to this, the children take home a reading book on a daily basis.

We expect a comment in your child's planner LEAST ONCE A WEEK.

Purple Mash

Purple Mash is a great resource for the children to be using at home. It has English, maths, science, computing, topic and art. Your child could look at things we have already learnt, or look at the topic and science section below to see what we are learning next half term.

Handwriting

In Year 4, children should be writing in joined handwriting with the letters a consistent size. Encourage your child to practice at home on a regular basis. They have a login in their planner for Letter-Join to help them learn the correct joins.

During Autumn 1, our topic has a geography focus; 'Misty Mountains, Windy River' and in science we are be focusing on solids, liquids and gases.

During Autumn 2, 'Ground Breaking Greeks' is our history topic. In Science lessons, the children will learn about 'Sound'
