You can help us to keep your children safe by following these simple rules of Safeguarding:

• Never leave your child alone on any of the school's playgrounds in the morning before 8.45am. Your child could easily leave the

school premises without our knowledge as our playgrounds are so busy. If you need to leave your child early please bring them to reception and they can go to breakfast club until the start of school.

- ALWAYS let us know first thing in the morning if your child is going to be absent from school. Our office is open from 8.00am Today we had 42 children absent and 11 parents did not contact us—it took until nearly 10 o'clock for us to get in touch with parents to check if the children were safe.
- Please do not encourage your child to come and speak to you when they are out on the St Agatha's Road playground—lunchtime supervisors have been advised to report any parents trying to speak to their child. It develops bad habits and encourages children to speak to strangers outside the school gates.
