

Computing – creating our own comic strip using a phone or tablet

Have a look at these examples of comic strips inside comic books



Comic books consist mainly of **pictures**!

They have lots of speech bubbles explaining what the characters are saying.

They sometimes have **captions** on the pictures to explain what is happening.

They often have [onomatopoeias](#) to show a sound that might be happening like:





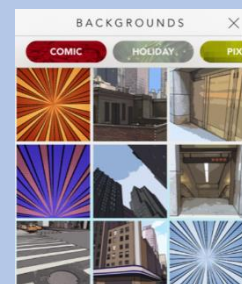
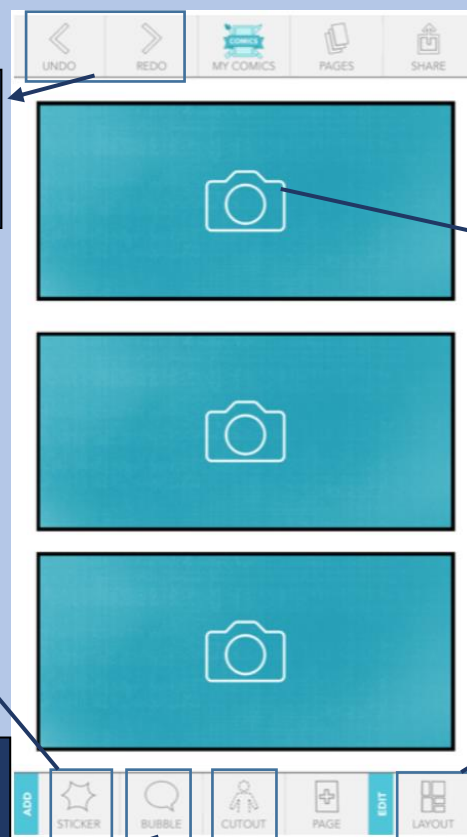
This app is called Seedling Comic Studio. You need to get permission from an adult to download this onto a phone or tablet. It is a FREE app.

We are going to use this app to make our very own comic strip.

If you make a mistake or want to undo something you can press undo here.



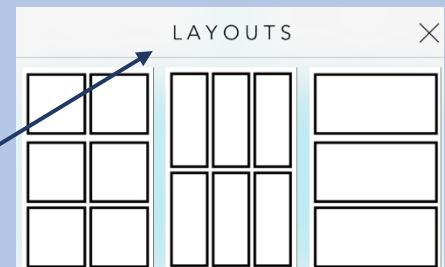
When you press on the camera button it will then allow you to change the background.



You can add different animation to your comic strip!



You can add different speech bubbles.



You can click on layouts and choose how you want your comic strip to look.



You can take a photo of someone or something and it does a cut out of them.



Here is an example of one I have made, which is just 3 things I do in the day. I used:

- Speech bubbles
- Backgrounds
- Cut out
- Stickers
- Onomatopoeia

See if you can create a comic strip more interesting than mine!

You could do one like mine about your day or you could try to create a superhero one with brothers/sisters or family members!

You can create more than one, you just need to click on "My comics" at the top and you can create a new one and your old one will save 😊
