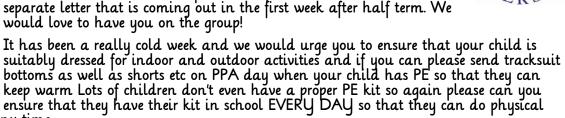

Healthy Flapjacks

Ingredients:

50q prunes (chopped), dried 50q apricots (chopped), dried 50q raisins 175q porridge oats 50q butter 3 tbsp Golden syrup 1 egg, beaten

Method:

- 1. Preheat the oven to gas mark 4/180'C/Fan oven 170'C
- 2. Mix all the dry ingredients together.
- Add melted butter with syrup (or honey)) into dry ingredients and combine well.
- 4. Beat the egg and when the fruit and oat mixture has cooled slightly, add this to the mixture.
- 5. Turn the mixture into lightly greased 9 x 7 inch/22 x 18cm baking tin.
- 6. Bake for 15–20 minutes until a pale golden brown.
